£25

would pay for therapeutic activities, such as a day out at a wildlife park, for recently bereaved children and young people. Helping them spend time with others who have had similar experiences, begin to express and manage their emotions and to have fun.

£250

would pay for a patient or carer to receive 12 sessions of counselling to help them understand and cope with their anxieties and grief and to face the future.

£5,200

would cover the costs of running our Hospice at Home service for one week, providing care for end-of-life patients in the comfort of their own home.

£27,500

would cover the costs of providing our Day Hospice for one month, delivering compassionate clinical care, respite and wellbeing therapies for our patients and their carers.

All of our services are free at the point of delivery but they are not free to provide.

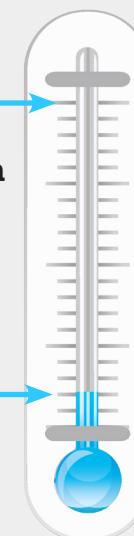
